

COVID-19 Vaccine Planning- Priority Distribution Plan
Updated on 2/4/2021

Only individuals 18+ yrs of age are eligible for the vaccine. To schedule an appointment, they must ensure they are registered patients at the Nisqually Clinic. Prior to vaccination, they will need to complete a vaccine screening and patient acknowledgment form. PER RESOLUTION 8-2021: We are vaccinating based on priority groups as required by the CDC. We have ensured there is enough vaccine allocated to Nisqually per our agreement with the DOH to vaccinate all of the populations outlined in this plan. *When there is an open vaccine vial and there are no appointments- to avoid vaccine waste- individuals outside of the Priority Distribution Plan may be put on standby to receive the vaccine.*

Please note that the estimated population numbers are based on internal departmental records- there is overlap between populations. For example, a Tribal Member may be an employee. Based on these estimates, we will have enough vaccine for all population groups.
