As you know, per Tribal Council Directive, it is required to quarantine after working fireworks unless you are fully vaccinated- this is a covid-19 safety precaution due to current infection rates in our area.

You must be fully vaccinated in order to avoid quarantine requirements. That means it must be 10 days from completing your vaccine series when you begin working firework stands.
