## Home-Testing Using Home Testing Kits – Available from Health Department, Law Enforcement, and Emergency Management

We have Home Test Kits available! The Medical Department is prioritizing patients who are experiencing symptoms, so that we can make sure they get the attention they need. If you are looking to get tested out of caution, because of an exposure, or another reason – check out our home testing kits!

#### Where can I get a Home Test Kit?

Please note: CDC guidelines currently recommend that you isolate yourself if you suspect that you may have Covid-19, please isolate and mask diligently until you have your results. If you have a positive home test, please isolate at home for 10 days. If you are a patient at Nisqually – give the Health Department a call. Or seek additional testing at a Thurston County Testing Site.

#### **Important Items to Remember**

- Tests are free
- We have multiple types of home test kits available. For some, a smart device (phone, iPad) with the ability to Bluetooth and receive messages is necessary- must be at least 50% charged.
- Important Note: Please complete your COVID self-test in a remote area to employ proper social distancing.

#### If you are symptomatic:

Any person experiencing COVID symptoms should isolate and schedule a test at the Nisqually Health Department or one of the Thurston County Testing Sites.

#### Self-Test Process and What to Do If You Have a Positive Test Result

- Be sure to follow the Home Test Kit directions closely
- If you have a positive test result call the Health Department to schedule a rapid test in the clinic OR if possible, check out our handout on Thurston County Testing Sites

# **COVID-19 Testing Locations**

There are many locations in Thurston County offering COVID-19 testing. Some locations have drive-through or walk-up testing services while others offer appointments in their clinics. Since every location handles testing differently, **please call** ahead of time.

We encourage anyone seeking testing to contact their health care provider first. Many local providers are offering COVID-19 testing to their patients.

Who should be tested for COVID-19? Use the CDC Self-Checker tool: <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/coronavirus-self-checker.html</u>.

- People who have <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>.
- People who have come into close contact with someone with COVID-19 should be tested to check for infection:
  - <u>Fully vaccinated people</u> should be tested 5-7 days after their last exposure.
  - People who are not fully vaccinated should get tested immediate when they find out they are a close contact. If their test result is negative, they should get tested again 5-7 days after their last exposure or immediately if symptoms develop.
- People not fully vaccinated with COVID-19 vaccine who are prioritized for expanded <u>community screening</u> for COVID-19.
- People who have been asked or referred to get testing by their healthcare provider, state, tribal, or local health department.
