

Nisqually DEESP Program Application

PURPOSE: The DEESP program was designed to perform needed repairs to ensure the safety of existing residential houses **owned** by Nisqually Tribal Elders residing in the reservation boundaries or within a 50-mile radius of the Nisqually Indian Tribe Reservation.

The work is scheduled on a first come, first served basis using a detailed and numbered list of applicants which is kept at the building department. The budget is **finite** and changes from year to year which will affect the number of Tribal Members that can be served each year.

Nisqually DEESP Policy 2025 & Guidelines

Program Guidelines:

- You must be a Tribal Elder (Age 55 or older) to qualify for this program.
- EMERGENCY situations only. Non-emergency situations will not be approved.
- Funds CANNOT be used to purchase appliances, including refrigerators, ovens, washers, and dryers.
- \$3,000.00 limit on emergency funds. If repairs exceed the \$3,000.00 limit, you may need to inquire about additional funding programs. The budget is **finite** and changes from year to year which will affect the number of Tribal Elders that can be served each year.
- Applicant must live within a 50-mile radius of the Nisqually Indian Reservation.
- Applicants will not contact any contractor nor go under contract with any contractor prior to Building Department approval.
- Pets must be controlled so that workers are not bothered or endangered by them.
- Workers must be treated respectfully while working on property.
- Access to areas of the house being worked on needs to be open to workers during daytime hours Monday to Friday.
- Pets must be controlled so that workers are not bothered or endangered by them.
- Workers must be treated respectfully while working on property.
- Change orders or additional work must be approved by the building department.
- Once application has been submitted, a project manager will contact you. You have 10 days to respond back to the project manager's initial query, otherwise you may need to re-apply for funds.
